

Rules for Holiday Lighting Contest

The Commissioners of Poolesville for the purpose of conducting and judging this event will appoint a committee.

The committee will set the dates during which the judging will take place. These dates will be made available for local press coverage.

Judging should be finished in time to announce the winners during the first Commissioners meeting in January.

There will be three categories of winners:

1. Contemporary
2. Traditional
3. Townhouse

No address may win more than once in a three (3) year period.

The Contemporary category is defined as those homes decorated in a style to fit today's environment. Lights, displays, etc.

The Traditional category is defined as those homes decorated in a style more traditional with older values. Wreaths, candles, etc.

The Townhouse category is the home selected as most appreciated by the committee and may include either Traditional or Contemporary decorations.

The committee can also choose a business as most appreciated by the committee.

Fisher Avenue will be the dividing line with one winner from each category selected from each side of Town.

An appropriate plaque will be established to reside at the Poolesville Town Hall listing the winners by year. Winners will also receive a certificate from the Town congratulating them on their efforts to beautify the Town during the Holiday season.
