



ALL: In accordance with RESOLUTION NO.: 3-20 we hereby request the street accessing the 8 lot, 18.45-acre, subdivision on the left as you enter Poolesville which is directly across from our home at 19101 Fisher Avenue be: 'WILD TURKEY WAY'. This qualifies under Category 4. A name of flora or FAUNA indigenous to the area.

Over the years there have been many flocks of turkeys crisscrossing our property whether it was under till or being used as hay land. Early in the season these flocks may have as many as 8-10 poults with them. I was recently mowing along our property line and watched a large tom turkey speedily trotting along the tree line at the back of the property and have also seen turkey feathers on our home property. Since the lots will be 2+ acres and additional trees will be planted along the existing tree line and our untreed property line which we anticipate will be an enhancement of their habitat.

SUBJECT: Policy for naming of streets, parks and fields.

WHEREAS the Pooleville Code, Appendix A - Subdivision Regulations, §22.G, provides that no street names shall be used which have not been approved by both the Planning Commission and the Montgomery County Planning Board; and

WHEREAS the Board of Parks, Recreation and Streets has recommended a policy and procedure for approval of new street names, parks and fields; and

WHEREAS the policy and procedure for assigning street names should be cross referenced in the Subdivision Regulations for the guidance on street naming;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of Pooleville, that the following policy and procedure for naming of streets, parks and fields in the Town of Pooleville is approved by the Commissioners:

A street, park and field name will be considered only if it falls into one of the following categories:

1. An individual who has at least ten (10) years of service with the Town in an elected and/or appointed capacity and is not currently in office or serving on a board or commission;
2. An individual who has made a significant contribution to the Town or Community;
3. A name with local historical significance;
4. A name of flora or fauna indigenous to the area.

Names will be submitted to the Town for review by the Parks Board. The Parks Board will forward its recommendations to the Planning Commission for review, and the approved names will be sent to the Town Commission for review and approval. Street, parks and fields names will be selected from the resulting list.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution pertaining to street naming shall be referenced in an editor's note to §22.G of the Subdivision Regulations.
