

**MINUTES
COMMISSIONERS OF POOLESVILLE
January 6, 2022**

***** This meeting was conducted virtually through ZOOM with live time posting to YouTube. Notice of the meeting date, time and agenda were posted in advance, physically at the Town Hall, on the Town's Website, and on social media. Prior to the start of the meeting, it was confirmed that the public could view the meeting on YouTube.**

CALL TO ORDER:

Vice President Radigan called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m. All Commissioners were in attendance, except for Commissioner Cook. Town Manager Tomasello and Town Attorney Gullo were also in attendance.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Commissioner Eck led the Pledge of Allegiance.

1. Vacancy in the Office of President

As Commissioner Cook submitted her resignation as President of the Board of Commissioners on January 4, 2022, the Board met to select a replacement. Town Attorney Gullo outlined the requirements of Charter Section 82-4 which govern this matter. After much discussion, Commissioner Eck made a motion to select Commissioner Brown as President. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Reed. Motion carried 3-0-1 with Commissioner Radigan abstaining

After additional discussion, President Brown made a motion to remove Commissioner Radigan as Vice President of the Commission. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Eck. After much discussion the motion carried 3-0-1 with Commissioner Radigan abstaining.

Commissioner Brown then made a motion to nominate Commissioner Reed as Vice-President of the Board of Commissioners. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Eck. Motion carried 4-0.

President Brown read the presiding officer's closing statement to adjourn the meeting into Closed Session pursuant to the Personnel exception of the Open Meeting Statute. A motion was made to go into Closed Session by Commissioner Radigan, seconded by Commissioner Eck. Motion carried 4-0 at 8:19 pm
