

**MINUTES
COMMISSIONERS OF POOLESVILLE
MAY 1, 2023**

Call to Order:

Commissioner Reed called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. Commissioners Paksima, Eck and Radigan were in attendance. Also in attendance was Town Manager Yost. President Brown joined virtually later.

Commissioner Radigan discussed the recent Planning Commission Comprehensive Plan worksession and the upcoming meeting.

Commissioner Paksima discussed Fair Access, the continued effort for clinic and community center funding, and a White's Ferry update.

Commissioner Eck discussed the May 3rd agenda, speed study and naming of parks/streets.

Commissioner Reed reported on Sustainable Poolesville projects including pick it up Poolesville, composting and Comp Plan input.

Old Business

Adoption of Ordinance 225 Fiscal Year 2024 Budget and Tax Rate – Manager Yost provided a summary on the Budget/Tax Rate and process. The Commissioner briefly discussed the process and how President Brown was in favor of the Budget. Commissioner Radigan motioned to adopt Ordinance 225 and the FY2024 Budget and Tax Rate. Seconded by Commissioner Paksima. Motion carried 4-0.
