

**MINUTES**  
**COMMISSIONERS OF POOLESVILLE**  
**May 24, 2021 – Special Meeting**

**\*\*\* This meeting was conducted virtually through ZOOM with live time posting to YouTube. Notice of the meeting date, time and agenda were posted in advance, physically at the Town Hall, on the Town's Website, and on social media. Prior to the start of the meeting, it was confirmed that the public could view the meeting on YouTube.**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

President Cook called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m. All Commissioners were in attendance. Acting Town Manager Evans and Town Attorney Gullo were also in attendance.

**THE PURPOSE OF THIS MEETING WAS TO DISCUSS AND MAKE DECISIONS REGARDING THE POOLESVILLE SUMMER YOUTH CAMP**

The Commissioners heard an update from Acting Manager Evans regarding the status of the hiring for the Summer Camp. At the last Commissioner meeting direction was given to move forward with plans to hold the Summer Camp so advertisement for a Camp Director and Camp counselors were done.

Ms. Evans informed the Commissioners that the plan would be for the Camp to begin on June 21 and last for 7 weeks. So far 8 Camp Counselors have applied – 3 returning and 5 new. The total amount needed is 11. No one has applied for the Director or Assistant Director position. The deadline for applications is May 27.

Discussion occurred regarding the cost; number of participants; and other variables that effect the Camp's operation, including Covid protocols and vaccinations.

After the discussion the Commission indicated that they believe there is no successful path forward at this time.

Commission Brown made a motion to cancel the Summer Camp for this season due to the reasons stated in the discussion. Commissioner Eck seconded the motion. The motion carried 5-0.

Commissioner Radigan made a motion to adjourn at 5:30 pm. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Reed. Motion passed 5-0.
