Zoning Regulations – Chickens, Resident Elizabeth Carpenter presented a request for consideration to allow chickens to be kept in residential zones. After a discussion, the Commissioners agreed to task the Planning Commission with developing recommendations for a potential zoning change.

Ordinance 220 – Accessory Structures - Manager Yost provided a briefing on the ordinance. Commissioner Radigan motioned to approve the ordinance. Seconded by Commissioner Reed. Motion carried 5-0.

### **Town Manager Report**

Manager Yost reported that the Ad for Assistant Manager would be going out this week and that he had contacted the hiring Committee. He reported that the July 5 meeting was cancelled, IT specialist was coming to evaluate meeting room audio visual equipment, and the water/wastewater department would be smoke testing sewers the next week or so.
