

Holiday Lighting Contest Rules

This contest is judged by members of the Friday on the Commons Committee.

Judging will take place December 14-17, 2023.

Winners will be announced at the Commissioners meeting in January.

There are four categories of winners:

1. Contemporary
2. Traditional
3. Townhouse/Apartment
4. Business

No address may win more than once in a three (3) year period

The contemporary category is defined as those homes in a style to fit today's environment – inflatables, netting, lights, displays, etc.

The Traditional category is defined as those homes decorated in a style more traditional with older values. Wreaths, candles, etc.

The Townhouse/Apartment category may include either traditional or contemporary decorations.

The Business category may include either traditional or contemporary decorations.

Fisher Avenue will be the dividing line with one winner from each category selected from each side of town.

Winners names will be added to the plaque at Town Hall by year. Winners will also receive a certificate from the Town congratulating them on their efforts to beautify the town during the holiday season as well as a \$50.00 gift certificate to a local business.
